Our Girls, Our Life



At Adcote, we are dedicated to supporting and guiding students on their academic journey through high-quality teaching and personalised attention.

From the moment a girl joins us in Year 7 or above, she is assigned a personal tutor who becomes her primary point of contact. This tutor regularly meets with both the student and her parents to discuss academic progress and pastoral care, ensuring a holistic approach to her wellbeing.

We offer specialised support through our SENCO (Special Educational Needs Coordinator) for students with specific learning needs, and we also provide access to an external counsellor who visits the school weekly to offer individualised, targeted support when needed.

Our students are encouraged to have a voice. Led by our prefect team, the 'Student Voice' forum provides an opportunity for girls to express their ideas, requests, and feedback, ensuring that their thoughts are heard and contributing to meaningful change within the school.

Mental health and well-being are central to our ethos, and we take a proactive, whole-school approach through our CLEAR Learning Programme. Resilience is a key focus, as we teach our students how to cope with change, overcome challenges, and build the confidence needed to succeed. We offer programmes in mindfulness and well-being, helping students manage stress and anxiety, and encouraging positive thinking. These skills lead to a healthier mindset and a greater understanding of the world around them.

For students needing extra academic support, we provide short booster courses that run alongside regular lessons, ensuring tailored education in small class sizes. In the Senior School, your daughter will have access to a wide variety of subjects and GCSE options that encourage academic and creative exploration. The Performing Arts, Fine Art, and Textiles play a central role in school life, enriching both the curriculum and extra-curricular activities. Our vibrant sports and cultural programmes foster initiative, ambition, responsibility, and compassion, preparing students to become well-rounded individuals.

In addition to core academic subjects, we provide a comprehensive curriculum that includes Physical Education, Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE), careers education, and work experience to ensure our students are prepared for future success. Our Girls Lead the Way

Adcote Sixth Form fosters a pre-university culture with high expectations, setting the stage for students to thrive academically and personally.

Research shows that girls perform better in single-sex environments, where they feel more comfortable asking questions, expressing their opinions, and taking intellectual risks. Adcote provides a supportive and nurturing atmosphere that encourages girls to reach their full academic potential. With six hours of subject time per week, a structured programme of assessments, and regular progress meetings with personal tutors, we ensure each student excels in their chosen specialist areas.

Our bespoke Sixth Form setting promotes a highly focused atmosphere, allowing girls to concentrate fully on their studies. This focus is crucial as they prepare for final examinations, helping them to stay on task and maximise their potential.

At Adcote, we emphasise the development of confidence and self-esteem by encouraging girls to take on leadership roles. Our prefect system, along with a Student Leadership Team led by a Head Girl, provides valuable opportunities for students to assert themselves and lead. Regular partnership meetings between the Student Leadership Team and the Headteacher ensure that students' voices are heard and acted upon. Girls also have the chance to lead initiatives such as the student-led Rotary Club for fundraising, as well as sports teams and debating societies, allowing them to develop leadership skills and explore their interests.

A close-knit community and a deep sense of belonging are integral to life at Adcote, especially in Year 12 and Year 13. Our girls form strong bonds with their peers and teachers, creating a supportive environment where they feel confident to speak up and express themselves. This strong sense of community nurtures personal growth and prepares them for life beyond school.

At Adcote Sixth Form, we expand horizons and equip our girls for a future full of possibilities, ensuring they are ready for university and the world beyond.

Boarding



A home-from-home experience

Our boarding houses are a safe, caring, friendly environment, where we create a strong sense of family, community and belonging based on traditional values.

Our homely boarding houses welcome girls between eight and eighteen and we offer full, weekly and flexi-boarding options to cater for all needs.

The Heads of Boarding and their team, who all reside on site 24/7 provide the care, comfort and support, which are so important to the girls' well-being and success. A Medical Officer is available during the school day for students.

Nurturing and guiding the youngest to the oldest, we encourage independence, confidence, self-discipline, a sense of responsibility and respect for other cultures throughout the houses. We have two boarding houses here at Adcote, where structure and routine are key. Aston Hall has twin rooms with en-suite facilities. In Norman House students are in rooms that typically sleep 2 to 6 students with separate bathroom facilities. Both houses have common rooms where the girls can relax, watch television, play games or have a hot drink and socialise.

Meals are eaten as a boarding community in our Darby restaurant and give opportunities to mix across houses and year groups. Our catering team accommodates all specialist diets and our menus are varied and healthy.

Our activity programme offers both onsite and offsite cultural, active and relaxation activities and we encourage our students to take advantage of what is on offer.

We welcome casual boarding for day girls, subject to availability, where the occasional overnight stay is needed such as a birthday celebration, a school production or for when parents need to be away from home.

We are proud members of the Boarding School Association (BSA) and accredited for the Forces Continuity of Education Allowance.









Our Girls, Our Support



Scholarships and Bursaries

At Adcote School, we are committed to making our exceptional education accessible through a range of scholarships and bursaries. Our scholarships, which are based solely on merit and not financial need, are awarded to girls who demonstrate exceptional talent and achievement.

These scholarships typically range from 20% to 30% off school fees and are available for entry into Years 7, 9, and 12, with occasional awards for other year groups. Categories include Academic, All-Rounder, Music, Sports, Art, Performing Arts, Gymnastics, and Sixth Form.

Scholarships are granted for the duration of the student's time at Adcote, provided they continue to meet the high standards and actively contribute to the area in which the scholarship was awarded. Candidates are assessed through a combination of academic testing, school reports, and an interview with the Head during Scholarship Day.

In addition to scholarships, we offer means-tested bursaries to provide financial support for families who may require assistance with school fees. Bursaries can offer up to 30% fee reduction and are available to students entering the school at any age. Families interested in bursary support are encouraged to contact the Head of Admissions for a confidential discussion and will need to submit a detailed application form, including full financial documentation.

International Scholarships are open to students of all ages irrespective of background.
