Secure Your Place

A deposit of £500 is required to secure your placement at the time of booking. Fees must be paid by Monday 8th April 2024. Any bookings after this date must be paid in full at the time of booking.

Cancellation

The Applicant is entitled to cancel their place on a Programme at any time before the Programme has started.

In the event of any cancellation by the Applicant, the Applicant must provide written notice to Adcote School.

If the notice of cancellation is received by Adcote School before the commencement of the Programme, the Applicant shall be entitled to receive a refund of the amount of Programme Fee received by Adcote School (less the Non-refundable Deposit of £500) calculated as follows:

+ 120 days	100%
90 - 119 days	50%
60 - 89 days	10%
0 - 59 days	0%

In the case of a visa refusal, a refund will be given if cancellation is received in writing along with a refusal letter.

Terms and Conditions

- In order to secure a place on a course an application form and deposit must be completed and submitted to the school or a recognised agent or partner.
 - The school reserves the right to alter the timetable and/or transfer students from one class to another or merge small classes if required and to transfer students to a different programme.
- It is the parent's responsibility to declare any medication that a student is taking and to declare any medical issues at the time of application.
- All images/videos of summer school students taken by the school may be used for marketing purposes.
- The school reserves the right to allocate alternative teaching facilities and accommodation without prior notification
- Fees are not transferable to other students and the school reserves the right to cancel or amend a course when necessary.

Course Rules
