### **Cancellation**

The Applicant is entitled to cancel their place on a Programme at any time before the Programme has started. In the event of any cancellation by the Applicant, the Applicant must provide written notice to Adcote.

If the notice of cancellation is received by Adcote before the commencement of the Programme, the Applicant shall be entitled to receive a refund of the amount of Programme Fee received by Adcote (less the non-refundable deposit of £400) calculated as follows:

Number of days prior to commencement of the Programme	% refund of Programme fees received less non-refundable deposit
60+ days	100%
45 - 60 days	50%
30 - 45 days	25%
0 - 30 days	0%

#### **Terms and Conditions**

- In order to secure a place an application form and deposit must be completed and submitted to the school or a recognised agent or partner.
- The school reserves the right to alter the timetable.
- It is the parent's responsibility to declare any medication that a student is taking and to declare any medical issues at the time of application.
- All images/videos of summer school students taken by the school may be used for marketing purposes.
- The school reserves the right to allocate alternative teaching facilities and accommodation without prior notification
- Fees are not transferable to other students and the school reserves the right to cancel or amend a course when necessary.

### **Programme Rules**

- Students are expected to attend all meals and organised activities and excursions.
- If boarding, students are required to keep their rooms tidy and to make their own beds.
- Consumption or possession of alcohol is not permitted.
- Drug taking or possession of drugs will result in instant dismissal from the programme.
