57% of A-Level grades at A*-A, with 93% of university offers coming from Russell Group establishments and one-third of students receiving a UK G5 university offer.


Superior Geographical Location

Terms and Conditions

- To secure course places, application forms must be completed and deposits paid, and submitted to Myddelton College or authorised agents or partners;
- The school reserves the right to adjust timetables;
- Parents are responsible for declaring any medications the student is taking and any medical issues at the time of application;
- Photos and videos of immersion students taken by the school may be used for marketing purposes (unless the student opts out on the application form);
- The school reserves the right to allocate other teaching facilities and accommodation without prior notice;
- Fees paid by students are non-transferable to other students, and the school reserves the right to cancel or modify courses when necessary.

Cancellation Policy

- Applicants have the right to cancel their course place before the course begins.
- Applicants must provide written notice to Adcote Schools to cancel their application.
- In case of visa refusal, applicants need to provide written cancellation notice along with the refusal letter.
- If Adcote Schools receives cancellation notice before the course begins, applicants are entitled to a refund of course fees collected by Adcote (Adcote will charge a £400 application fee), calculated as follows:

Days before course starts	Refund percentage
60+ days	100%
45 - 59 days	50%
30 - 44 days	10%
0 - 29 days	0%

If applicants fail to provide written notice as specified above, they forfeit their right to a refund. Refund processing requires 30 working days after receiving complete materials. The school reserves the right of final interpretation.

Visa Refusal Situations

If a student visa is refused, the school will reconsider a refund on a case-by-case basis, provided that the visa application has been refused and a refusal report is provided, but no refund will be given if the visa is refused for any of the following reasons:

- If the visa application does not comply with UK Visas and Immigration (UKVI) immigration regulations, no refund will be given;
- If false documents are submitted, or false and deceptive information is used in the visa application, no refund will be given.
