

School Fees for the Academic Year 2026 - 2027

In line with UK Government legislation, independent school fees are now subject to VAT.

All fees listed below are inclusive of VAT.

Registration Fee

For all students, a non-refundable registration fee of £300.00 is payable when you register your child for a place at Adcote School.

*Pupils progressing from one key stage to the next are not required to pay a further registration or application fee.

Security Deposit

An acceptance deposit of £500.00 is required when the formal offer letter from the Head is received; this guarantees your child a place at the school. This deposit is held and refunded, less any outstanding charges, on the pupil leaving the school.

School Fees Include:

At Adcote School we attempt, as far as possible, to include all elements of your child's education in the fee so that parents are aware of the total cost. Therefore, we do not apply charges for the following:

- Any travel associated with school sports matches (excluding optional trips)
- All timetabled sports
- Wi-Fi
- Boarders have all meals, accommodation, bedding, laundry & supervised studies included

Additional Charges

These may include but are not limited to the following:

- Minibus Services
- School Uniforms
- Taxis and Airport Transfers
- Music Lessons
- Offsite Educational Activities and Excursions
- Examination Fee's
- Offsite Weekend Activities and Excursions

Minibus Service

Adcote School operates several week day mini-bus services. The school endeavours to ensure there is an opportunity to support every family that requires the service, enabling their children to get 'to and from' school each day safely.

Additional Academic and/or Language Support

Charges for additional academic and/or language support are arranged on an individual basis, subject to the level of support required.

Discounts, Scholarships and Bursaries

- Sibling Discount - A 10% reduction is applied to the fees per additional sibling. The reduction is applied to the eldest of the siblings at the school.
- Armed Forces Discount - The School offers all those parents who serve, or have served, in the Armed Forces of the Crown a 20% discount off the full School fees. When used in conjunction with the Boarding School Allowance, this makes our boarding fees a very affordable option.
- Other Awards - The School also offer discounts to pupils whose parents are in the Diplomatic Corps (10% of full fees) and of those who have a parent in the Adcote Association (Adcote Old Girls) (10% of full fees). The School also makes provision to provide bursaries to daughters of the clergy of the Church of England or Anglican Communion.
